Dear Axie,

On behalf of the outdoor recreation community, we want to share our heartfelt thanks for your service to the outdoor recreation economy and its wide benefits for the people of New Mexico. High-quality outdoor recreation infrastructure and access ensure fulfilling and healthy lives for all Americans, and your work exemplifies this relationship. New Mexico's outdoor recreation economy, which accounts for \$2.3 billion (2.1%) of the state's GDP and 28,475 jobs, is in a great position thanks to your leadership.

We want to highlight a few of your accomplishments in particular:

- Created the first-of-its-kind Outdoor Equity Fund to enable all New Mexican youth equitable access to the outdoors. The grant supports programming that provides outdoor experiences that foster stewardship and respect for New Mexico's land, water, and cultural heritage. Since Gov. Michelle Lujan Grisham signed the Outdoor Equity Fund into law in April 2019, the program has granted \$2 million to nearly 130 organizations throughout the state.
- Secured technical assistance from the National Park Service's Rivers, Trails and Conservation Assistance program to create a statewide outdoor education and industry strategy. The plan builds a pathway from pre-K through higher education for students interested in working in and for the outdoors, and emphasizes early outdoor access through programs like the Outdoor Equity Fund.
- Sponsored the Outdoor Economics Conference in Taos on October 5-7, 2022. About 375 people attended to hear about successful economic development efforts within and outside of New Mexico that are connected to protected lands.
- Launched the first-ever Outdoor Pitchfest, now the annual Adventure Pitch at the 2022 Outdoor Economics Conference.
- Awarded Outdoor Recreation Trails+ Grants to support 66 projects that enhance communities' outdoor recreation
 opportunities and contribute to economic development, prosperity, and wellness, including trails, river parks, wildlife viewing
 areas, and more.
- Led a successful petition to designate 125 miles of rivers in New Mexico as Outstanding National Resource Waters based on their "outstanding" recreational significance to the state.
- Announced the launch of an innovative New Mexico MainStreet (NMMS) and Outdoor Recreation Division (ORD) collaboration to connect communities' downtowns with their natural resources. The "Outdoor Recreation Asset Atlas" will study five counties and the end result will identify up to five trail creation or improvement projects connected to MainStreet districts.
- Acted as chair and vice-chair of the Confluence of States in 2021 and 2022 respectively.

As evidenced by the work above, your impact on outdoor recreation will be appreciated by New Mexico's residents and visitors alike for years to come, and we will miss your leadership in the role. Thank you again for your commitment to promoting outdoor recreation and its benefits, and we wish you the best in your next chapter.
