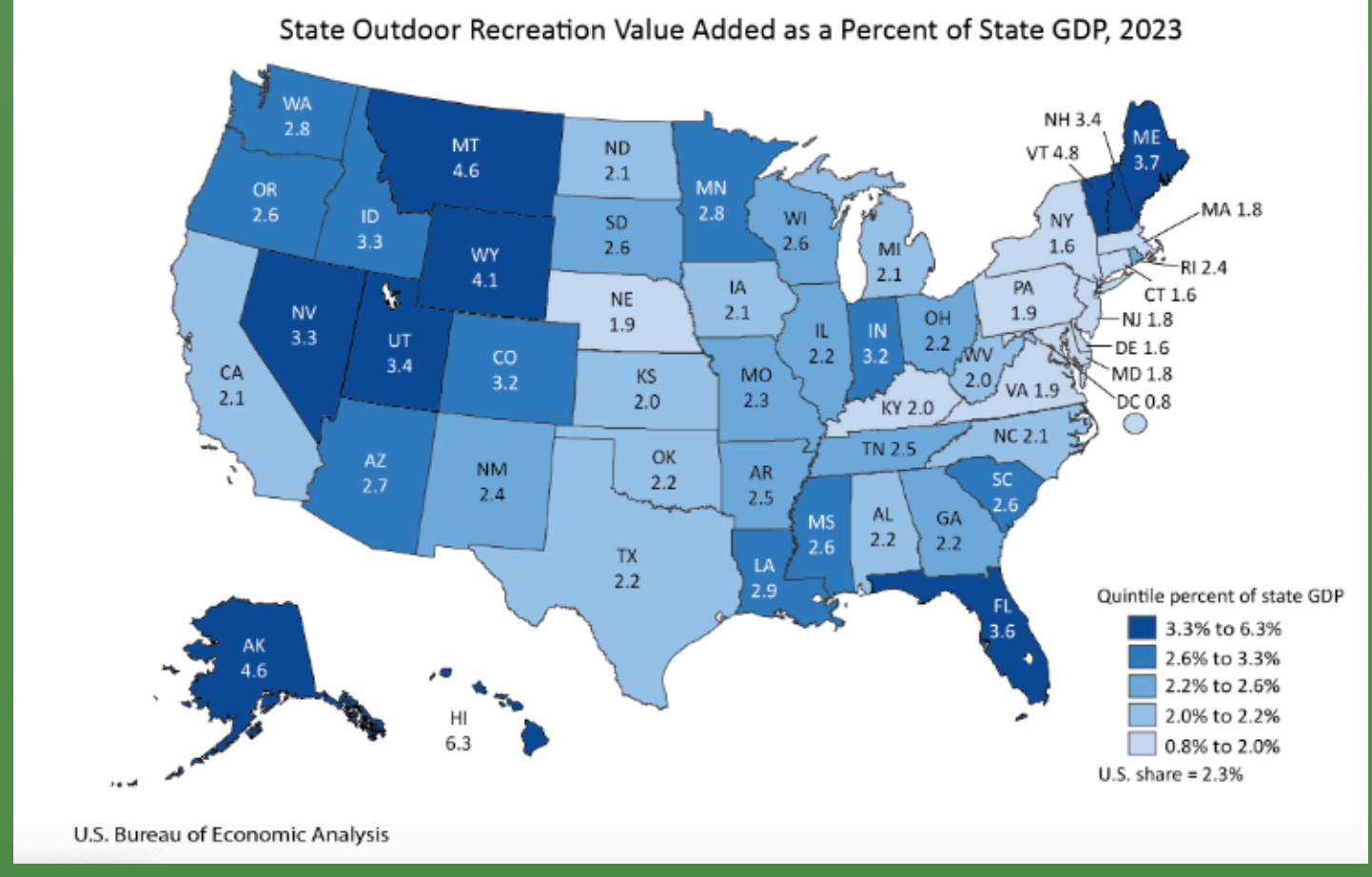


Below are rankings of state outdoor recreation economies as measured by the U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis Outdoor Recreation Satellite Account in 2023.
